1	Jeremiah 32:17	Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. There is nothing too hard for You.
2	1 John 4:4	You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.
3	1 John 4:7	Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.
4	Pslams 28:7	The LORD <i>is</i> my strength and my shield; My heart trusted in Him, and I am helped; Therefore my heart greatly rejoices, And with my song I will praise Him.
5	Nehemiah 8:10	Then he said to them, "Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; for <i>this day is holy</i> to our Lord. Do not sorrow, for the joy of the LORD is your strength."
6	Philippians 4:4	Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!
7	Proverbs 18:24	A man <i>who has</i> friends must himself be friendly, But there is a friend <i>who sticks</i> closer than a brother.
8	James 4:6	But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."
9	James 4:10	Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up.
10	Philippians 4:7	and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
11	James 1:19	So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath;
12	Proverbs 15:1	A soft answer turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up anger.
13	Isaiah 26:3	You will keep <i>him</i> in perfect peace, <i>Whose mind is stayed on You</i> , Because he trusts in You.
14	Matthew 5:9	Blessed <i>are</i> the peacemakers, For they shall be called sons of God.
15	Luke 6:38	Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."
16	1 Corin 2:11	For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God.
17	2 Corin 9:6	But this <i>I say</i> : He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.
18	Romans 8:26	Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
19	Isaiah 53:5	But He <i>was</i> wounded for our transgressions, <i>He was</i> bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace <i>was</i> upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.
20	Psalms 103:3	Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases,
21	1 Thess 5:17	pray without ceasing,
22	Luke 18:1	Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart,
23	Proverbs 18:10	The name of the LORD <i>is</i> a strong tower; The righteous run to it and are safe.
24	1 Corinthians 13:13	And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these <i>is</i> love.
25	1 John 4:18	There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.
26	Mark 11:25	"And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses.
27	Mark 11:26	But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses."
28	Psalms 119:105	Your word <i>is</i> a lamp to my feet And a light to my path.
29	Colossians 3:16	Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
30	Proverbs 30:5	Every word of God <i>is</i> pure; He <i>is</i> a shield to those who put their trust in Him.
